



Minutes of Maltby Town Council Meeting
Held on Thursday 1 August 2019

	<p>Present: Councillors: S Biggin (Chair), R Price, P Heaps, C Beaumont, C Beresford, J Bradford, A Dickinson, J Kirk, R Price, A Rushforth.</p> <p>In attendance: P Parkin RFO and 7 members of the public.</p> <p>Public Session:</p> <p>A request was made for an update on the new build / renovation of the Edward Dunn Memorial Hall. The Chair said a committee has been established to consider all options prior to public consultation.</p> <p>A member of the public sought clarity on the liability insurance cover, risk assessment and road closure arrangements for events such as the remembrance day parade. It was agreed to clarify this with RMBC.</p> <p>Concern was expressed as to overgrown vegetation in Maltby. Similarly, concern was expressed about unsafe parking in Maltby including on pavements. The Police explained that they could not take action against parking on yellow lines. The Chair agreed, together with the member of the public, to report these issues to RMBC Streetpride immediately. Also, the Council would contact parking services to seek action on inappropriate unsafe parking in Maltby. Cllr Bradford asked for an update from the Clerk on our previous discussions with Insp. Bakewell.</p>
