- c) **Santa's Grotto:** Council members raised concerns with the increase in local COVID-19 cases.

RESOLVED: For the grotto to be cancelled and books to be distributed to local schools to minimise the risk to children.

- d) **Christmas Light Switch On:** The Clerk confirmed that all the arrangements for the event had been confirmed.

RESOLVED: That the Council review the event at the next meeting.

- e) **Pensioners Christmas Lunch:** Council members raised concerns with the increase in local COVID-19 cases.

RESOLVED: For the event to be cancelled due to the increasing local COVID-19 cases and to consider arranging a similar event at Easter.

- f) **Christmas lunches: Restover Lodge:** Cllr Biggin asked Council to consider providing a Christmas lunch to the people staying at Restover Lodge over the Christmas period. The facility is used by RMBC to house homeless people. The Three Tunns at Stainton have agreed to provide a 3-course meal for £25.00.

RESOLVED: For the project to be approved.

- g) **Awards Ceremony:** Cllr Sutton suggested arranging an event in the Summer.

RESOLVED: For the event to be discussed in January.
