GP20/47 LICENSING APPLICATIONS FOR THE SERVICE STATION ON ROTHERHAM ROAD

The Committee were informed that Councillor Biggin attended the Licensing Panel and objected on behalf of the Council, she advised some residents attended and also objected. Unfortunately the objection was not upheld.

TO RECEIVE AN UPDATE ON THE ALLOTMENTS

Limesway Allotments – the Clerk advised that an allotment holder had contacted her to ask if she could share their plot with someone else, due to her and her partner working for the NHS and working additional hours due to the pandemic.

RESOLVED: that the Clerk writes to the plot holder to advise them that they can share their plot adhering to a set of new rules and that the sharing of the plot will be reviewed yearly.

The Clerk advised that she had sent out a strong letter to Limesway allotment

holders regarding fires, parking on the grassed area and the fact that the office would not speak to a plot holder regarding another plot unless it was due to health & safety reasons.

GP20/48 TO RECEIVE AN UPDATE ON THE CLEANING OF SNICKETS AND GENNELS

The Committee requested the following areas to be cleaned:

- Grubbing out Don John

The Clerk advised that she would speak to RMBC again regarding the snicket that leads to White City and she would gain costs for the grubbing out waste removal.

It was agreed that due to the current pandemic and government restrictions that a clean up could not go ahead, however, the office could start working on Covid-19 risk assessments for a clean up.
