a)Craggs Meadow

Thomas Best from Maltby Craggs Steering Group attended the meeting to discuss the history of the site and the work carried out by the group to encourage native wildflowers to grow. A member of the public also attended the meeting to provide details of the Millennium Field Project, the member of the public advised that he had arranged a site meeting with RMBC to discuss the site and would provide feedback to the Clerk at later date.

Council members discussed the information received; Cllr McMahon proposed arranging a meeting with RMBC to discuss all green spaces within Maltby. No resolutions were approved.

b)Coronation Park Bowling Greens: Cllr McMahon advised that a pile of unused chairs had been on the site for several months. A member of the public questioned how to book the facilities. The Clerk agreed to contact the club to make enquiries about both matters.

c)Coronation Park Tennis Courts: The Clerk advised that the surface of the court requires cleaning to remove a build up of moss, quotes will be sought and brought to a future meeting. Members queried how to book the courts and Clerk confirmed that members of the public can book through an online system with Premier Tennis.
