2021/149	<p>A member of the public made a request for an agenda item to be added to provide updates to the public.</p> <p>A member of the public requested an update regarding the proposed fencing for Limesway allotments. Cllr Biggin confirmed that the Council are looking at alternative options for the site as the quotes received for fencing were excessive of the budget. The member of the public advised that he had erected a fence to secure the site, no objections were raised towards the erection of the fence.</p> <p>A member of the public attended the meeting to discuss the Maltby main Colliery Roll of Honour Board which is now with the archive department at RMBC. A request for support was made to work towards retrieving the board for public display in a safe location.</p> <p><u>RESOLVED:</u> That the Council support the request and write to St Bartholomew's Church to confirm the decision.</p> <p>A member of the public advised that he had received a copy of the last report produced by Maltby Wood Lee Common and Craggs Meadow Steering Group and made a request for Councillors to visit the meadow. Cllr McMahon advised that the General-Purpose Committee would be discussing the meadow in January, the member of the public was invited to attend the meeting. Cllr McMahon also suggested inviting the steering group members and RMBC to the meeting.</p>
