2021/92	<p><u>APOLOGIES AND REASON FOR ABSENCE</u></p> <p>Cllr Biggin, Dickinson, Fitzgibbon, Heaps and Webster.</p> <p><b>RESOLVED:</b> That the apologies be approved.</p>

2021/94	<p><u>PUBLIC PARTICIPATION</u></p> <p>A resident requested feedback on the matters previously reported to the Council and emphasised the requirement for the Council to deal with litter and dog fouling issues. The Clerk confirmed that the Council do employ a contractor to deal with litter within the town.</p> <p>A resident reported an issue with a hedge between St Mary's and Birks Holt, the Clerk agreed to deal with the matter.</p> <p>A resident reported concerns with vehicles being parked on footpaths, potholes, and overgrown hedges. Cllr Tinsley agreed to discuss the issues with the resident after the meeting.</p> <p>A resident raised concerns with the height of the colliery tip, RMBC had previously confirmed that the height could not be increased but this does not seem to be the case. Cllr Tinsley advised that he had a meeting arranged with Hargreaves later in the month and would raise the concerns at the meeting.</p> <p>A resident complained about the state of land between Lidl and Maltby Skate Park, Cllr Tinsley advised that he had contacted Lidl about the issues.</p>

	<p>A resident attended the meeting to discuss matters relating to Limesway allotments. Cllr Sutton advised the resident that the matter would be discussed at the General-Purpose meeting on the 9<sup>th</sup> of September. The meeting was suspended for a short period. Cllr Kirk advised that the resident could attend the meeting on the 9<sup>th</sup> and would be permitted to speak.</p>
